



TRAFFIC IMPACTS Northern Davis and Weber Counties

**2015 Larry H. Miller Tour of Utah
Stage 3 presented by Zions Bank - Wednesday, Aug. 5
Antelope Island State Park to Bountiful
Race Time 10:05 a.m. to 2:30-2:45 p.m.**

Listed here are probable impact areas and timelines for businesses and motorists who will be using the same roadways as the Tour of Utah in northern Davis and Weber counties.

Impact Areas

- The race will begin on Antelope Island at the intersection of Antelope Island Road at Marina Road.
- After crossing the causeway to the mainland, the race will use 2000 West, 1800 North, and 5000 West to enter Weber County. The race is expected to pass through Hooper from 10:50 to 11:15 a.m.
- The race will use SR 134/4700 West through West Heber and Plain City, passing these areas from 11 a.m. to 11:45 a.m.
- The race will continue to 2200 North, turn East and then turn North on 4100 West. The race will then turn East on 2600 North and continue East for four and one half miles. Businesses in the area of 2700 North can expect delays/closures in this area between 11:15 a.m. to 12 Noon (2700 North will be closed during this time.) We understand the effect this may have on traffic/customers in the area and will open the road as quickly and safely as possible after the race has passed.
- The race will turn North on 600 West and continue to 3100 North, where the race will turn east to access the North Ogden Divide. The anticipated time frame that this area will be impacted will be from approximately 11:15 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. This includes the closure of the North Ogden Divide.
- Once over the North Ogden Divide the race will turn South on 3500 East and then head southeast on Nordic Valley Drive. The race will turn South on 5500 East and then East on 1900 North. The race will then turn south on 7100 East until reaching 500 North where it will turn east. Once the race reaches 7800 East/Hwy 39 it will turn south following the road as it turns west. The race will turn south on Trappers Loop Road. The approximate time frame that the race will be in the Ogden Valley will be from 12 Noon to 1 p.m.



General Guidelines

- Passing is NOT permitted by any motor vehicle along the road being used by the professional cyclists or authorized race caravan vehicles. Traffic is allowed to follow behind the race, but only at race speed.
- If you are traveling toward the race (in the opposite direction of the race), the Utah Highway Patrol will be controlling all traffic at certain intersections, treating this as a rolling road closure.
- Without alternate routes, please be patient as some substantial delays may occur.
- A portion of the race routes for the Larry H. Miller Tour of Utah pro cycling race will be located partially on the Dixie National Forest and Uinta–Wasatch–Cache National Forest.
